

## Suggested Installation Instructions for Product Number: 106–132 Vinyl Prep

Performance Choice Vinyl Prep is a high strength combination of solvents and water. This fine product not only removes stains, wax, silicones and grease from the surface, but also creates a slight softening of the vinyl film and prepares the surface for topcoating such as with Performance Choice Color Coat.

## **Directions for Use:**

Clean items to be painted with mild soap and water. Spray surface to be painted, giving special attention to recessed areas. Rinse with water and allow to dry. Where multiple coats of wax are present, use Vinyl Prep liberally and rinse well, repeating process until water no longer beads on the surface.

DANGER! EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE! CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE. VAPOR HARMFUL. KEEP AWAY FROM CHILDREN. CONTAINS HYDROCARBON PROPELLANT and 107982 GLYCOL ETHER PM. Do not spray near sparks, heat or open flame. Vapors will accumulate readily and may ignite explosively. Keep area ventilated during use and until all vapors are gone. DO NOT SMOKE. Extinguish all flames, pilot lights and heaters. Turn off stoves, electric tools, and appliances, and any other sources of ignition. CONTENTS UNDER PRESSURE. Avoid prolonged exposure to sunlight or heat from radiators, stoves and other heat sources that may cause bursting. Do not puncture, incinerate, burn or store above 120° F.

**CAUTION:** Do NOT allow VINYL PREP to stand on any painted surfaces as discoloring or lifting may occur.

Do not discard empty can in home garbage compactor. Use with adequate ventilation. Avoid continuous breathing of vapors or spray mist. Open windows and doors or use other means to ensure fresh air entry during application and drying. If you experience eye watering, headaches or dizziness, increase fresh air or wear respiratory protection (NIOSH/ MSHA TC 23C or equivalent) or leave the area.

HARMFUL OR FATAL IF SWALLOWED. If swallowed do NOT induce vomiting. Get medical attention immediately. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. FIRST AID: In case of eye contact, flush thoroughly with plenty of water for 15 minutes and get medical attention. For skin contact, wash thoroughly with soap & water. In case of respiratory difficulty, provide fresh air and call physician. Reports have associated repeated & prolonged occupational overexposure to solvents with permanent brain damage and nervous system damage.

INTENTIONAL MISUSE BY DELIBERATELY CONCENTRATING AND INHALING THE CONTENTS MAY BE HARMFUL OR FATAL.
