



**Suggested Installation Instructions for Product Number:
309-534 6-Volt To 12-Volt Wiper Motor Conversion**



Note: This unit must be grounded, or it will not work. Also, it must be installed in an area where nothing could fall or lay against it. The unit could reach 90 degrees.

DIRECTIONS FOR SAFE AND PROPER INSTALLATION OF CONSTANT VOLTAGE-CURRENT GENERATOR

Bugs - underhood:

Remove dash protector, drill 5/16" hole on drivers side of radio - or just behind speaker and mount the unit with wires toward fuse box. **Remember unit must be grounded.**

Next, you must locate hot lead or power wire to the wiper switch. On bugs with a fuse panel through fire wall, it should come from the last fuse (drivers side). It should be one of the wires (two wires to one clip), one to turn indicator box, the other to the wiper switch. When the right wire is determined, cut and strip 1/2" off each end. Connect the black wire from it to the wiper switch wire, red or orange to fuse or power lead. Replace the dash protector. Start the engine, turn the wiper switch on, adjust the wiper speed, and turn off switch. **Do not use this unit for shut off.**

Station Wagons, Buses and Vans:

Install where convenient. **Remember unit must be grounded.**
