

## Suggested Installation Instructions for: 602-668, 1963-1982 Rear Wheel Bearing Greaser

- 1. Raise rear of car. (Be safe! Use a jackstand.)
- 2. Remove half shaft. Items 54, 60, & 61.
- 3. Remove spindle nut, washer & flange. Items 6, 7, 8 & 9.
- 4. Place greaser over spindle, through deflector and seal. Item 10 & 13. Replace washer and nut 6 & 8. Tighten finger tight.
- 5. Grease bearing with about four tablespoons (seven to nine shots with a grease gun) of GM 1052497 (a tube for grease guns) or equivalent. Check with a GM Dealer Parts & Service Department about the grease you should use.
- 6. Remove greaser and replace all items in reverse order.
- 7. Repeat on opposite side of car.
- 8. Lower car.
